KIWI VIEWING IN NOCTURNAL HOUSES:

Please note that we have up to six kiwi on display in nocturnal houses at any one time at the Ōtorohanga Kiwi House. The light level in the nocturnal house is deliberately low to simulate moonlight for the kiwi. The human eye takes 5-15 minutes to adjust to the low light level before visitors can see clearly. This is particularly challenging for visitors as they age. Please ensure your clients are made aware of the light level before entering each nocturnal house so they can adjust their night vision and understand the environment they will be entering. Depending on the timeframe visitors are visiting in they may not always see a kiwi up close. If this becomes a difficulty during your group's tour please alert our staff to the issue and they will attempt to assist the group with seeing a kiwi. We can not guarantee that each visitor will be able to see a kiwi up close in the nocturnal house as sometimes kiwi remain in their burrows or forage at the back of their enclosures where they may be difficult to see. The longer visitors spend on site the higher their chances are of seeing kiwi up close. We do have burrow cameras set up so if the kiwi is inside its nestbox they can be viewed on the large digital screens at the entrance to the enclosures.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR GUIDES TO SUPPORT ANIMAL **ENCOUNTERS HELD THROUGHOUT THE DAY**

KEA & NI KAKA

The world's only alpine parrot species, kea are unique to the South island of New Zealand.

Kea require a high level of intelligence and social behavior to survive in a harsh alpine environment.

Fewer than 5000 kea remaining in the wild. They are threatened by introduced mammalian predators and interactions with humans and human activity i.e. lead poisoning and road accidents.

NI Kaka are considered to be at risk although their numbers are increasing thanks to predator free sanctuaries like Zealandia and Maungatautari.

NI Kaka, like kea, are omnivorous and exceptionally clever and stripping bark to find insects and foraging over wide territories for seasonal fruits.

Kea and NI Kaka at the Kiwi House receive enrichment activities daily which provide sensory stimulus or problem solving opportunities such as maze puzzles and swinging baskets or wrapped boxes, box/climbing towers and iceblocks/snow.

KAKARIKI/PARAKEETS

There are five species of kakariki in NZ - 3 are on display at the Kiwi House; red crowned, yellow crowned and Antipodes Island Kakariki. Each are endangered due to mammalian predation and habitat loss.

Antipodes Island Kakariki live on an inhospitable sub-Antarctic island so have developed the intelligence to burrow, forage widely and occasionally hunt baby penguins for protein.

·Flocks of up to 1000 red and yellow crowned kakariki were present in the 1950s. Due to deforestation they began to decimate agricultural crops so were once culled in large numbers.

Yellow crowned kakariki prefer living high in the forest canopy while red crowned kakariki will often forage on the forest floor.

LONGFIN EEL

•The Kiwi House has 40+ reclusive longfin eels in our pond systems ranging in size from in size from 10 centimeters to up to 2 meters long.

-Longfin eels are endemic to NZ but most migrate to shallow water breeding grounds near Tonga at the end of their life cycle - at about 70 years of age.

'Glass' Elvets are swept back to NZ on ocean currents and darken in colour when they reach freshwater and begin their journey inland to establish a territory.

-Longfin eels are critically endangered due to commercial and recreational fishing, water quality issues and human activity such as dams, roads and culverts blocking natural migration pathways.

BIRDS OF PREY

•The Kiwi House houses two endemic species, NZ Falcons/Karearea and Morepork/Ruru

Birds of prey have binocular vision to enable them to judge distances and timing to catch prey on the move. You will often see them bobbing their heads to change the angle they see prey from to assist in depth perception of their target.

NZ falcons are endangered so the Kiwi House breeds falcons for release to the wild. Outside of breeding season we train our falcons to catch prey thrown in mid air so they maintain this ability. They are extremely agile and are found in forested areas. Moreporks are often heard at night with their double hoot that sounds like their name 'Ruru'. They fly silently with soft rounded flight feathers.
